



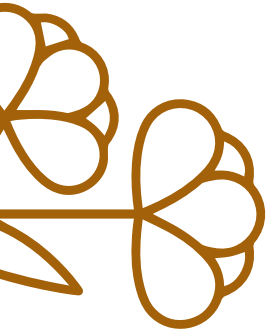
# IDAHO OILSEED Commission

Crops currently assessed include: mustard, canola, flax, and safflower.



The IOC funded canola research projects this past growing season that dealt with biostimulants, Kerb herbicide, herbicide strategies in canola, and more.



In conjunction with University of Idaho, the IOC was awarded a **Specialty Crop Block Grant** for studying better agronomic practices for irrigated mustard.



A tax of ten cents per hundredweight is collected on oilseed crops grown in Idaho.
